Anthony Fisher OP. Monsignor Randazzo, 49, is a priest of the Archdiocese of Brisbane and priest-in-residence at the Cathedral (in Brisbane). Fr. Umbers, 45, is a priest of Opus Dei and has carried out extensive pastoral work in Sydney. When ordained, these men will be amongst Australia's youngest bishops. With Archbishop Anthony, 56, they represent the “generational change” presently occurring amongst the leadership of the Catholic Church in Australia. Archbishop Anthony said he was delighted with the appointments and warmly welcomes both priests to the work of the Archdiocese. *Let us pray for Mon. Randazzo and Fr.
