#### St Jerome

Jerome was a Latin Catholic priest, confessor, theologian, and historian. He is best known for translating most of the Bible into Latin. He has also written commentaries on the Bible. He is often seen with a skull. The skull represents seat of thought and also spiritual perfection.

#### St Therese of the Child Jesus

Therese Martin was the last of nine children born to Louis and Zelie Martin on January 2, 1873, in Alencon, France. At 15, she entered the Carmelite convent in Lisieux to give her whole life to God. She took the religious name Sister Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face. She loved flowers and saw herself as the "little flower of Jesus," who gave glory to God by just being her beautiful little self among all the other flowers in God's garden. The title "little flower" remained with St. Therese. She lived a hidden life of simple prayer. Countless millions have been touched by her intercession and imitate her "little way." She has been acclaimed "the greatest saint of modern times. She was canonized by Pope Pius XI on May 17, 1925.

### **Holy Guardian Angels**

Guardian angels are not only for children. Their role is to represent individuals before God, to watch over them always, to aid their prayer, and to present their souls to God at death.. A feast in honor of the guardian angels was first observed in the 16th century. In 1615, Pope Paul V added it to the Roman calendar.

#### St Francis of Assisi

Saint Francis of Assisi was a Catholic friar who gave up a life of wealth to live a life of poverty. He established the Franciscan Order of friars and the women's Order of the Poor Ladies. Francis was born in Assisi, Italy in 1182. He is remembered for his generosity to the poor and his willingness to minister to the lepers. There was even a time when Saint Francis quieted a flock of noisy birds that were interrupting a religious ceremony! Much to the wonder of all present, the birds remained quiet until Francis' sermon was complete.

St Francis performed many miracles, many dead were raised to life., many blind regained sight.. He was the first saint to receive the Stigmata of Christ.
