### **Face Masks**

NSW Health is now strongly recommending everyone in our state to wear a face mask in crowded public areas and while on public transport.

The advice is that masks should be worn in supermarkets, shops, churches and other places of worship as well as on public transport.

The recommendations are not yet compulsory, but are "strongly recommended" for situations in an enclosed space where social distancing can't be guaranteed.

### **August devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary**

August became known as a month dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The reason why, is because of World War II and the devotion of Pope Pius XII to Our Lady of Fatima. The world was in turmoil in the 1940s and in 1942, Pope Pius XII responded to the requests of Our Lady of Fatima and consecrated the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on October 31, 1942. On May 4, 1944, Pope Pius XII established the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on August 22. After the revision of the General Calendar, Pope Paul VI decided to switch the feasts of the Immaculate Heart and the Queenship of Mary. The feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary was joined to the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (celebrated on the Saturday following the feast of the Sacred Heart, typically in June) and the Queenship of Mary was moved to August 22. This was to recognize the fact that Mary's Queenship is closely connected to that of her Assumption into heaven.
