COVID-19 Safety Plan

Our Covid-19 Safety Plan (copy available in Church) states :

1. All must be aware of content of Safety Plan.
2. Those with Flu symptoms must not enter the Church.
3. Sanitizing hands and registration strict requirement in order to come inside the Church.
4. Required sanitization of the seats before and after mass.
5. Holy Communion on hand. Keep 1.5m distance when receiving communion.
6. Social distancing 1.5 apart (only 200 seats).

Spectacular light show at the St Mary's Cathedral


