COVID-19 update

The NSW Government has announced a further easing of COVID-19 restrictions on churches, which are in place this weekend. Singing is now allowed in places of worship, as long as masks are worn and a one person per four square metre rule is observed. If no congregational singing takes place, places of worship are allowed to have one person per two-square-metres with no maximum cap.

Up to 300 people can attend funerals and weddings, providing a two square metre rule is observed.

The COVID Safe Plan for Places of Worship strongly encourages electronic collection of worshippers' names and contact details. Many parishes are doing this by online registration for Masses rather than a QR code and can continue doing so. Parishes may keep paper records and then transfer this data across into an electronic format. Record keeping is compulsory.

COVID-19 Safety Plan

Our Covid-19 Safety Plan (copy available in Church) states :

- 1. All must be aware of content of Safety Plan.

- 4. Congregational singing with masks ONLY.
- 5. Required sanitization of the seats before and after mass.

Towards the end of **Lent** you may notice purple cloths draped over the crucifixes, statues, and saint images. This reminds us in a visual way that our faith in all its glory is made possible only through the work of Christ in his suffering and death on the cross. When we cover or remove these holy and sacred images we are reminded of all that Christ has won for us. The tradition is often practiced during the last two weeks before Easter, starting on Passion Sunday (now called the fifth Sunday of Lent) and ending on Good Friday. This time period is known on the old liturgical calendar as *Passiontide*. Even though this period is no longer officially called by this name, the tradition is still practiced. In a dramatic unveiling, the holy images are again revealed for the Easter Vigil to mark the end of the penitential season. The joy of the Easter season and the hope of the Resurrection.
