The traditional conditions to attain a Plenary indulgence

A plenary indulgence can be gained only one per day. The faithful must be in the state of grace and these three conditions must accompany the prescribed act.

- 1. The faithful must receive the sacrament of confession, either eight days before or after the pious act is performed,
- 2. Receive Holy Communion on that day.
- 3. and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary is the minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added).

Indulgenced Acts for the Poor Souls:

One can gain a plenary indulgence by visiting a cemetery each day between November 1 to November 8. These indulgences are only applicable to the Souls in Purgatory.

A plenary indulgence, again only applicable to the Souls in Purgatory, is also granted when the faithful piously visit a church or a public oratory on November 2. In visiting the church or oratory, it is required that one our Father and the Creed be recited.

A partial indulgence (the person does not meet the requirements above or still influenced by venial sin) can be obtained by devoutly visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed, even if the prayer is only mental during the year but especially during the month of November.
