St Lucy

Lucy came from a wealthy Sicilian family. She vowed to remain a virgin in the tradition of St Agatha.. An angry suitor reported her to the local Roman authorities, who sentenced her to be removed to a brothel and forced into prostitution. Lucy became immovable and could not be carried away. She was next condemned to death by fire, but the flames did not harm her. Finally, her neck was pierced by a sword and she died. Lucy was probably a victim of the wave of persecution of Christians that occurred late in the reign of the Roman emperor Diocletian. Her Feast day is December 15th. In Sweden, St Lucia's Day marks the beginning of the Christmas celebration. On that day the eldest daughter of the family traditionally dresses in a white robe and wears as a crown an evergreen wreath studded with candles. The festival is meant to bring hope and light during the darkest time of the year.
