## Petition—Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill

Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP has warned NSW MPs that the rights of faith-based medical and aged care providers will be seriously threatened, unless amendments are made to euthanasia laws set to be passed by the State's Upper House. "Voluntary assisted dying" is one step closer to becoming law in New South Wales after a Second Reading vote in the Legislative Council on 11 May passed 20-17. After the upper house debates amendments to the Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill next Wednesday, NSW will become the final state to fall to euthanasia in Australia. Dr Brendan Long our CEO has been working closely with the Catholic Archdiocese of Sydney to sponsor this paper petition in order to overturn the Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill 2021. The petition needs to be signed with the name of person and address of the person (who need to be over the age of 18). These paper petitions will be available at the Church Foyer. **Please sign petition against a voluntary euthanasia bill.**
