August devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and Assumption.

August became known as a month dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The reason why, is because of World War II and the devotion of Pope Pius XII to Our Lady of Fatima. The world was in turmoil in the 1940s and in 1942, Pope Pius XII responded to the requests of Our Lady of Fatima and consecrated the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on October 31, 1942. On May 4, 1944, Pope Pius XII established the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on August 22. After the revision of the General Calendar, Pope Paul VI decided to switch the feasts of the Immaculate Heart and the Queenship of Mary. The feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary was joined to the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (celebrated on the Saturday following the feast of the Sacred Heart, typically in June) and the Queenship of Mary was moved to August 22. This was to recognize the fact that Mary's Queenship is closely connected to that of her Assumption into heaven. The Assumption signals the end of Mary's earthly life and marks her return to heaven to be reunited with Jesus. The feast was introduced to Rome in the 8th Century by Pope Sergius and from there it spread rapidly throughout western Europe, with Pope Hadrian later giving the Feast Day its official name as the Assumption of Mary towards the end of the Century. On 1st November, 1950, the day after the closing of the International Marian Congress in Rome, Pope Pius XII solemnly defined the dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven.
