Epiphany blessing.



The Christmas season, especially the feast of the Epiphany, is a traditional time to bless homes.

Leader: Peace be to this house.

All: And to all who live here.

Leader: Bless, O Lord, this household and family, and allow all of us who live in this home to find in it a shelter of peace and health. Inspire each of us to develop our individual talents and to contribute wisdom and good works for the benefit of the whole family. Make our home a haven for us all, and a place of warmth and caring for all our friends who come to visit us. Enlighten us with the brilliance of your Epiphany star so that, as we go into the world, we might clearly see our way to You and discover You in our work and play.

All: For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory now and forever.
Amen.



Blessed chalk for your house blessing are now available in the church foyer for you to take home.

The ceremony of the blessing of the home and inscriptions of the initials of the three Magi above each door can be performed either by a priest or the head of the family.

The following prayer may be said: "Bless, O Lord God almighty, this home, that in it there may be health, purity, the strength of victory, humility, goodness and mercy, the fulfilment of Thy law, the thanksgiving to God the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. And may this blessing remain upon this home and upon all who dwell herein. Through Christ our Lord. Amen."

After the prayer is recited, the initials, C. M. B are inscribed upon the doors with the blessed chalk.

For example: "20+ C+ M+ B + 23".

(The initials, C, M, B, can also be interpreted as the Latin phrase "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" which means "Christ bless this house".) The initials also correspond to the traditional names Casper, Melchior and Balthazar.
