Immaculate Conception

Friday 8th December is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. The feast focuses on the concept that the Virgin Mary was conceived without sin. It is one of the four Marian dogmas of the Catholic Church. Debated by medieval theologians, it was not defined as a dogma until 1854, by Pope Pius IX . Special prayers are also made as part of the feast. It is one of the most important Marian Feast of the year and is celebrated worldwide. Through her special relationship with the Holy Trinity as the Mother of Jesus Christ, Mary is the most powerful saint in heaven. She intercedes for us and guides us to her Son Jesus so that we can know Him and love Him. When we learn about her, we understand her beloved Son better. Mary always points to Jesus. It is the joy of her life to lead others to Him. That is why the moon is a symbol of Our Lady. Just as the moon has no light of its own, but reflects the light of the sun, so Mary reflects the True Light of the Eternal Son. Mass at St Michael's Parish Church will be at 9.15am.

Advent Prayer

My loving Jesus, I choose You, this Advent, as my King and my God. I abandon myself to You and seek to put all my trust in Your tender care. Draw me close to You and free me from my sin so that I may love You with a pure and holy heart.

St Ambrose

St Ambrose was a successful lawyer prior to becoming a bishop. He is one of the four original doctors of the Church. He is the Patron saint of Milan. He is credited with composing the "Antiphonal Chant," which is a method of chanting where one side of the choir alternatively responds to the other. It is believed by many, that when St Ambrose was an infant, a swarm of bees landed on his face and left behind a drop of honey. His father saw this as a sign, that Ambrose would become someone great and have a wonderful sense for speaking. His feast day is 7th December, the date of his ordination.
