Father Jules Chevalier

Father Jules Chevalier is a Roman Catholic priest born in Richelieu, France. Chevalier was initially apprenticed as a shoemaker at age 12 after he was told his parents could not afford to send him to the seminary. He was later able to join the seminary, after his father's boss sponsored him and at the age of 30 was sent to the parish of Issoudun. He was the founder of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart and the sisters congregation, Daughters of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Congregation (PBHK). He is an inspiration for Chevalier family members. The month of October is dedicated by the whole family of BHK schools as the Chevalier month to commemorate the death of Father Jules Chevalier precisely on October 21, 1907.

Laetare Sunday

Laetare Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent, takes its name from the Latin word which begins the entrance antiphon for that day. *Laetare* means *rejoice*, and this Sunday is marked by a relaxation of the penitential character of the Lenten season. In church, flowers may be used to adorn the altar on this day. Signs of joy are allowed on this day, expressing our belief in the hope of the resurrection and to inspire us as we continue our Lenten commitments to prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Symbolizing joy, rose-coloured Mass vestments can be worn instead of purple, to indicate the contrast between Laetare and the other Sundays of Lent. The use of rose vestments probably stems from an ancient papal tradition of blessing golden roses which would be sent to Catholic heads of state in Europe on the Fourth Sunday of Lent. The Fourth Sunday of Lent was once called Refreshment Sunday, or the Sunday of the Five Loaves, for the miracle of the boy with loaves and fishes in the Gospel of John.
