This Christmas Novena uses the biblical titles of Jesus that appear in the Liturgy of the Hours at Vespers (evening prayer) on the final eight days before Christmas. **16th Dec:** O Shepherd that rules Israel...**17th Dec** O wisdom that comes out of the mouth of the Most High...**18th :** O Adonai and Ruler of the house of Israel...**19th** O Root of Jesse, which stands for an ensign of the people...**20th:** O Key of David, and Sceptre of the house of Israel...**21st:** O Dayspring, Brightness of the everlasting light, Son of justice...**22nd:** O King of the Gentiles, yea and desire thereof...**23rd:** O Emmanuel, our King and our Law-giver. Longing of the gentiles...**24th** O thou that sites upon the cherubim, God of Hosts. *Recite one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Glory Be*.
