### **Our Lady of Fatima Procession Saturday, 11 May at 6pm,**

**Walk with Our Lady of Fatima in a candle-lit procession around St Mary's Cathedral as we pray for the needs of the Church and our world.**

### **Our Lady of Fatima—13th May**

Our Lady of Fatima is the title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary in connection with her apparitions to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal. Our Lady of Fatima told the shepherd children to pray the rosary daily for the end of the war (World War I). Mary continued to appear once a month for 6 months to the three children, Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco. Mary showed her presence to the children through the famous "Miracle of the Sun" on October 13, 1917. Approximately 50,000 people witnessed the sun change colours and dance in the sky in circular moves. In October of 1930, the Bishop of Leiria-Fátima approved the visions as "worthy of belief." Our Lady of Fatima is known for her powerful intercession, especially for **healing and strength** to endure any trial.

### **Prayer to Our Lady of Fatima**

*O Most Holy Virgin Mary, Queen of the most holy Rosary, you were pleased to appear to the children of Fatima and reveal a glorious message. We implore you, inspire in our hearts a fervent love for the recitation of the Rosary. By meditating on the mysteries of the redemption that are recalled therein may we obtain the graces and virtues that we ask, through the merits of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Redeemer. Amen*
