First Holy Communion Sunday 27th August

First Holy Communion is one of the three sacraments of Initiation, along with Baptism and Confirmation. It is through these sacraments that we become full members of the Church. The Holy Eucharist refers to Christ's body, blood, soul and divinity that are present in the consecrated host and wine (now called Body and Blood of Christ) on the altar. First Eucharist is unique among the Sacraments as it is the heart of our faith. It is the most powerful way in which we encounter the real presence of Jesus Christ. First Holy Communion is considered one of the holiest and important occasions in a person's life. We who celebrate are also transformed, becoming Christ's presence to others, and recognising the presence of Christ in others. Please have our First Holy Communion Candidates in your prayers.

St Bartholomew

Bartholomew was one of the twelve apostles of Jesus according to the New Testament. He is said to have been martyred for having converted Polymius, King of Armenia, to Christianity. Besides being listed as an Apostle, he is not otherwise mentioned in the New Testament, at least not under the name Bartholomew: many ancient writers, and Catholic tradition have identified Bartholomew as Nathaniel in the Gospel of John (John 1:45-51, and 21:2). Philip introduced Bartholomew to the Lord. When told that the Messiah had arrived and that he was Jesus of Nazareth, Bartholomew's response was, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" which prompted Jesus to say, "This man has no guile" (John 1:47); in other words, he speaks his mind. John's Gospel mentions Bartholomew as one of the Apostles to whom the risen Christ appeared at the Sea of Galilee after his Resurrection. Bartholomew is believed to have carried the Gospel to India, Mesopotamia, Persia, Egypt, and Armenia. The remains of St. Bartholomew were transferred to two churches in Italy: Benevento and the Church of St. Bartholomew-in-the-Tiber in Rome. This saint's main symbol consists of three knives representing his gruesome death
