in the pews.**

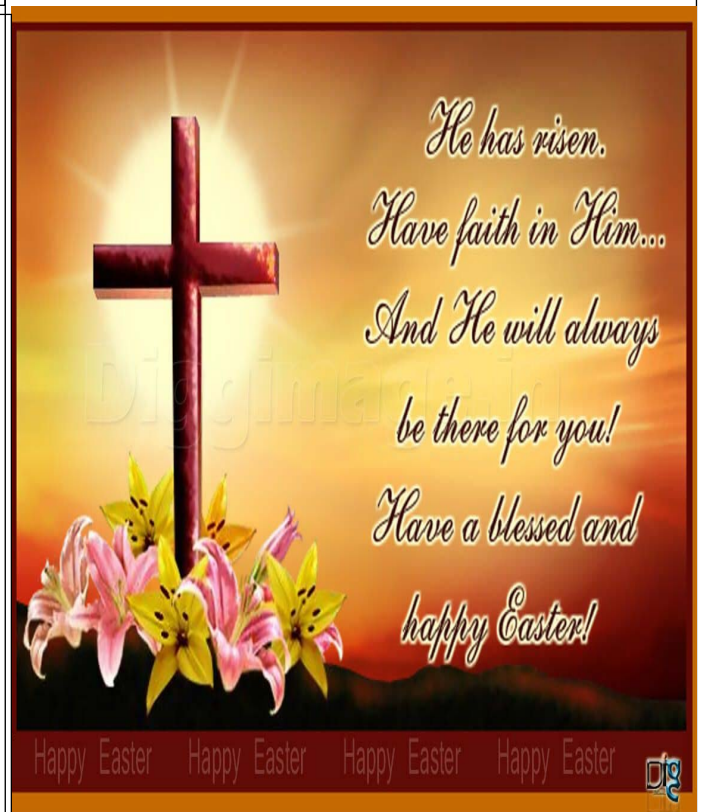
Catholic Easter Prayer
