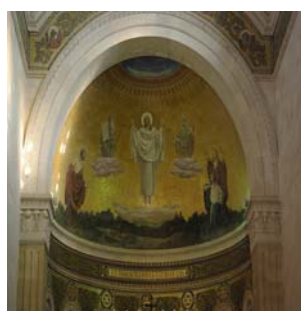


CWF August Parish Appeal

The **Church of the Transfiguration** is a Franciscan church located on Mount Tabor in Israel. The architect was Antonio Barluzzi. It is traditionally believed to be the site where the Transfiguration of Jesus took place, an event in the Gospels in which Jesus is transfigured upon an unnamed mountain and speaks with Moses and Elijah. Mary Mackillop

MacKillop was born in Australia to poor Scottish immigrants. In 1866 MacKillop and Woods **found-
ed Australia's first order of nuns**, the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart, and also established St. Joseph's School in a converted stable in Penola, in South Australia, providing a free education to children from the area. Mary was beatified on 19 January 1995 at Randwick Racecourse, Sydney, in a Mass celebrated by Pope John Paul II. She was canonised as Saint Mary of the Cross at a Mass celebrated by Pope Benedict XVI in St Peter's Square in the Vatican on 17 October 2010.
